CODE OF CONDUCT

Admission as a Camp Cullen or Camp Pine Tree camper carries its privileges and responsibilities. We expect campers to participate in the total life of camp – to work, play, worship and live together. We do not allow the use of tobacco, alcohol, illegal drugs, or weapons. Signing signifies understanding and acceptance of these responsibilities. Violators will be dismissed without a refund. In addition, should a behavior problem, discipline problem or homesickness affect our work with other campers, or their enjoyment of camp, we reserve the right to dismiss, without refund, those campers responsible. Some of our rules include the following. However, this is not an all-inclusive list.

- Physical aggression, violence, or threatening is prohibited.
- Cursing/swearing is prohibited.
- Throwing objects is prohibited.
- Kissing, hugging, holding hands, leaning against each other and other public displays of affection are prohibited.
- Do not disobey a counselor or person of authority.
- Knives, sharp objects or any other types of weapons are not allowed on camp.
- Always ask your counselor for permission to leave your bunkhouse.
- Always use the buddy system. Your buddy must be of the same gender and from the same bunkhouse.
- No food is allowed in the bunkhouse.
